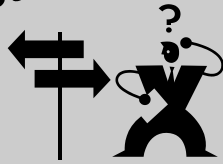

They are available 24 hours a day and links are listed on the Library Home Page. When using them from home, a password is required. Bookmarks listing eBooks and passwords are found in the library.

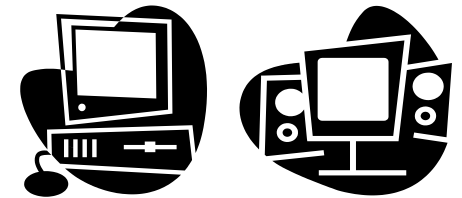
At RMHS we have two different sets of eBooks:

Media Center Policies

- Students are welcome to use the Media Center during operating hours with a pass from their teacher or as part of the entire class in the computer lab or collection area. The Media Center is available to students before and after school, and during breaks. Students need their student ID and hall passes if they are visiting during class hours without a teacher.
- An RMHS **ID card is required** to check out books, textbooks, and playaways.
- Most books are checked out for a **2 week** period and can be renewed as long as needed. Books are stamped with the due date, and students can access their current checkouts online.
- Students may have **4 library books** checked out at one time (including textbooks).
- A **fine of \$.10 a day** is assessed on overdue books and **\$.25 a day** for overdue playaways, reference, and textbooks. A grace period of 1 day is granted before fines are assessed.
- If books are damaged, students will be assessed a fine. If books are destroyed or lost, students will be assessed the cost of the book, plus an additional \$5.00 fee to cover replacement expenses.
- The color printer may be used by students. Color copies are **\$.10 each, prepaid** to the Media Center staff.
- **No food or drinks of any kind are allowed in the library, under any circumstances.**



Destiny Quest

Destiny Quest is our online catalog. Books can be located in many ways:

Keyword—largest search by single word

Title—can type in any word in book's title

Author—use author's last name

Subject—when looking for a particular subject area like “humorous fiction” or “historical fiction” or “football”

Other search options: Genre, Series, Awards, Publication Year, Language, Pages, and Location.

All Freshmen are given an orientation in the Media Center, by the Media Specialist, on how to search the online card catalogue and use the Media Center resources. Orientations are set up by the Freshmen English teachers.

Student Media Center Log-In

Students are able to access their current information by logging in on the **RMHS Library Home page**. This can also be done from home. Just click the “log in” button located in the upper right hand corner on the Home page.

Username = their 10 digit student ID#

Password = Student birthday in 6 digits MM/DD/YY

Listed under **MY INFO** is information about materials checked out including: due date, date checked out, overdue alert (red date), fines, and price of the material.

Computers and Labs

We have two computer labs located in the Media Center and additional computers on the main floor available for school-related student use before school, breaks, and after school. These labs are reserved for in-class work, ISAT testing, and Registration through the Media Center staff. We have the master calendar posted as a link on the Rocky Mountain School Library Home Page.

We expect students to adhere to the following rules, at all times, while using computers during operating hours:

- Students are **not allowed** to access their personal email, unless it is academic-related.
- Students are **not allowed** to play games of any kind.

All computer usage needs to be academic-related, and students are required to “accept” the terms of the policy set forth by the district before logging onto the computers. Violations of these rules will result in removal of internet access or complete removal of privileges and access to the Media Center.

Research Resources

Besides our non-fiction book collection and encyclopedias, the Media Center offers many online research opportunities. Online Database links are found on the RMHS catalog Home Page in the upper left hand area and can be accessed at school and at home. When opened from home a password is required.
